Dress smart casual on course and for dinner. Please feel free to bring a change of clothes. The Titirangi Golf Club provides it's own towels. Please note jeans are not permitted on the course or in the clubhouse. Golf shoes require soft-spikes. Hire clubs, trundlers and shoes are available by phoning the pro-shop on 826-5580 in advance.

As this is a three-person team Ambrose Golf event, an official handicap is not required however handicap limits will be set for the day by the match committee for players without an official handicap. Registered players will use their handicap index to calculate over all team handicap. Team captains should calculate this immediately on their arrival at the course.

Tournament rules and briefing will be circulated to team captains in advance and explained at registration on the day.

Golf Haggles \$100 per team. The golf haggles include nearest pins, hole in one prize a chance to win a car, the longest drive and three chances per team to use long drive champion Davyn Nola's drive to help your team score!
